What is USF?

The Universal Service Fund was established to facilitate the expansion of Telecommunications Infrastructure and Services to unserved and underserved areas, institutions serving the public, special interest groups, and maritime areas.

How does the process work?

Projects approved for funding are implemented by telecom providers and managed by the applicant submitting the proposal or an institution agreed upon by the NTRC.

Who can submit proposals?

Anyone can submit a project idea.

Priority Areas

- Expansion of broadband networks with emphasis on rural, unserved, and underserved communities
- Promotion of affordable broadband access for individuals with special needs, the elderly, and low-income families
- Enhancing access to telecommunications services within institutions serving the public (e.g., schools, hospitals)
